Born 29th July 1950 in Otley, England. Grew up and educated in Zimbabwe and completed my tertiary education at Rhodes University, Grahamstown, South Africa with B.Sc. Geology in 1972 and a M.Sc. (Mineral Exploration) in 1983.

I am registered as a Professional Earth Scientist (Pr. Sci. Nat), a statutory registration with the S. A. Council for Natural Scientists. Geological Science - Reg. No. 400074/03 and a member of the Geological Society of South Africa.

I have worked over 40 years in exploration and project management mainly in south, central and west Africa and now undertaking exploration implementation services in sub-Saharan Africa. This work has entailed exploration and resource estimation contracts mainly involving pegmatite/greisen mineralization; Archaean gold and nickel; vanadiferous magnetite; copper/cobalt in Ugandan carbonatites and the Zambian/DRC Copperbelt; kimberlite search in Zimbabwe and Tanzania; and platinum exploration on the Great Dyke and Bushveld Igneous Complex.
